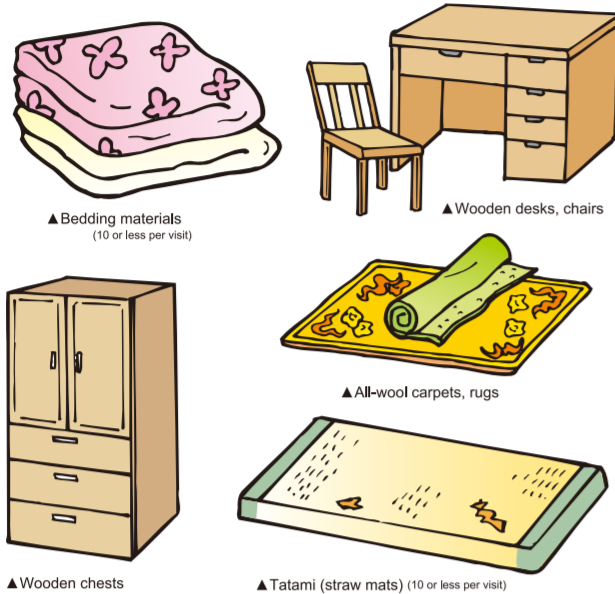


Items to a Clean Center

[Burnable large garbage items]

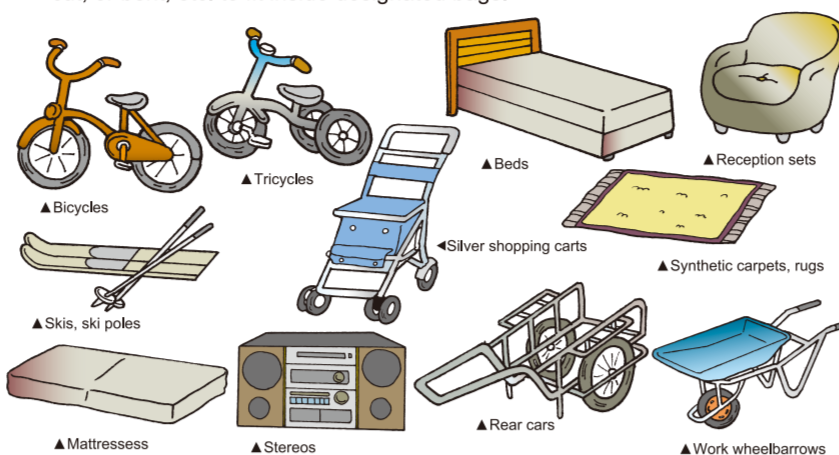
- Even things which do not fit in designated bags in their current state can be placed with regular garbage at collection locations if they are disassembled, cut, or bent, etc. to fit inside designated bags.
- Please remove metal parts, or glass, etc., as much as possible.
- Garbage cannot be brought in bags where the contents cannot be seen or cardboard boxes.
- Please bring any large amounts of garbage resulting from one-time events, such as moving or large cleanups, directly to the Clean Center.
- Please see back side for disposal fees, etc.



Things to be disposed of using a waste processing company

[Non-burnable large garbage items]

- Please bring oversized trash which cannot be combusted directly to the waste disposal company (a disposal fee will be charged)
- Even things which do not fit in designated bags in their current state can be placed with regular garbage at collection sites if they are disassembled, cut, or bent, etc. to fit inside designated bags.



[TVs, air conditioners, refrigerators, freezers, washing machines, clothes dryers]

- According to the Electric Appliance Recycling Law, the store where item was purchased, or store where replacement is purchased, will take the old model (there is a disposal fee).

[PCs]

- PCs made by a manufacturer will be taken by that manufacturer or the store where purchase was made.
- PCs purchased October 2003 or later have a disposal fee included in the purchase price (for PCs purchased in Japan).

[Garbage not accepted by the city]

Please consult with a waste processing company, or the store where item was purchased, etc.



Other garbage which the city may deem unsuitable

[Motorcycles (two-wheeled vehicles)]

- Please contact your nearest motorcycle recycle shop or the Motorcycle Recycling Call Center (Tel: 050-3000-0727). (There is no recycling charge)

Obeying the rules makes our city a nice place to live!

Garbage that is against the rules will not be collected!

- **Non-designated bags**
When bags other than those designated by Ueda City are placed in garbage collection sites.
- **Garbage is poorly separated**
When burnable and non-burnable garbage is together
- **When garbage has not been drained properly**
When organic waste has not been properly drained
- **Insufficiently bundled**
When garbage is insufficiently bundled, such as when the bag opening is not fully closed, etc.
- **Large garbage items**
Items that do not fit inside designated bags are classified as large garbage items. Large garbage cannot be placed in garbage collection sites.
- **Name is not written**
When the community association and personal name (full name) are not written on the designated bag
- **Business garbage (small businesses only)**
Bags other than small business-use designated bags will not be collected. The permission of the community association leader and application to the city are necessary.
- **Very large amounts of garbage.**
Very large amounts of garbage from such one-time events as moving, etc. will not be collected from collection sites. Up to 2 designated bags may be placed in a collection sites on one collection day (in the case of moving, up to 4 bags may be placed).

Items placed at collection sites

[Burnable garbage]

Please place in a designated burnable garbage bag (printed in blue).

(Kitchen garbage) • Please carefully drain fluids from garbage.
 • Please compost organic waste and return as much as possible to the soil.

(Paper waste) • Please separate and recycle as much recyclable paper as possible.

(Leather, fabric items)

(Plant/tree waste)

(Other)

• If it is difficult to put plant waste in bags, please bundle in sections of less than 70cm in length and 30cm diameter (with no branch more than 8cm thick), and tie a designated large garbage bag with your name written on it.

• Only one item of bedding material "Futon" may dispose one collection day. Fold it into a small size, and attached with a "Large" size designated burnable garbage bag.

• Mattresses are classified as non-burnable large garbage items.

[Plastics marked with ♻️]

Please place in a ♻️ marked designated bag (printed in green).

- Wash leftover food and soiled items, wipe, dry, then place in designated bags.
- In some cases, there is no ♻️ mark on the actual container.
- Please do not place bags inside bags. Put them in the designated bags and not bags such as plastic grocery bags.

Items shown include: Cup noodle containers, food containers, retort bags, styrofoam, trays, wraps and films, shampoo/detergent containers, fabric bags, plastic shopping bags, PET bottle caps, bento containers, mayonnaise/sauce containers, snack bags, beverages/yogurt containers, cooking oil bottles, egg cartons, and hors d'oeuvre containers.

[Non-burnable garbage]

Please place in designated non-burnable garbage bags (printed in red).

(Metal items)

(Synthetic leather/rubber/plastic items)

(Glass, porcelain items)

• Small electric appliances may be placed in designated non-burnable garbage bags.
 • Remove the batteries and place them with "Hazardous waste".
 • Please remove the oil and batteries from oil heaters.

Items placed at recyclables collection sites

Paper

• Please carefully bind in a cross pattern according to paper type.
 • For small papers, please insert them inside bundles of large papers.
 • Please do not bind with tape or wire.

(Newspaper, advertisements) Newspaper and advertisements can be bundled together.

(Magazines) Bundle similar sizes together as much as possible.

(Paper cartons) Rinse with water, cut open and tie together after drying. Do not insert thick paper into a bundle of cardboard.

(Miscellaneous trash) Paper boxes for tissues, snacks, wrapping paper, old envelopes, plastic wrap, empty toilet paper rolls, pamphlets, scratch paper, printer paper, etc.

Items that cannot be collected [Please place the following items as burnable garbage.]

- Treated paper (carbon paper, waxed paper, veneer [waterproof] treated paper, waterproof paper treated with gold or silver, oiled paper, thermal paper, impact paper, fax paper, paper carton with metallic silver inside)
- Dirty items such as paint, oil, etc.

Fabric items

• After laundering, group together and place in clear plastic bag to ensure that they do not spill free

Items that cannot be collected [Please place the following items as burnable garbage.]

- Items other than the 17 items at right (blankets, curtains, suits, ski wear, jackets, undergarments, socks, fabric cuttings)
- Dirty items such as paint, oil, etc.

Fabrics which include cotton, and are among the 17 listed here:

White shirts, t-shirts, blouses, casual shirts, aprons, sheets, futon covers, heated table covers, wiping cloths, trainers, baby clothes, cushion covers, polo shirts, pajamas, towels, yukata, bundling cloths (furoshiki)

Bottles

• Beer bottles, large liquor bottles should be returned to store of purchase. (Because they can be reused)

• Clear bottles, Brown bottles, Other colored bottles

• Caps and plastic items Remove labels

• Place metal caps in non-burnable garbage Place plastic caps in ♻️ marked plastics

• Juice, Cooking oil bottles (Carefully rinse oil away), Whiskey, Wine, Coffee bottles, Cosmetics bottles

Items that cannot be collected [Please place the following items as non-burnable garbage]

- Broken bottles, ceramic bottles, milk-colored bottles, glass utensils, window glass, etc.
- Please consult with the store of purchase regarding pesticide and dangerous drug bottles.

Cans

• Cans include beverage, food, medicine, pet food, can lids, motor oil cans, etc.

• Please place steel cans and aluminum cans together

• Rinse the inside, wipe and generally clean (Carefully rinse oil away)

• Crush the openings of wide-mouthed steel cans (to keep aluminum cans from getting inside)

• Soft drink Beer, etc.

Items that cannot be collected [Please place the following items as non-burnable garbage]

- 18-liter drums, pails, cans which contained paint, bottle caps, aluminum pet food containers

PET bottles

• Beverage (juice, oolong tea, sports drinks), liquor (sake, shochu, cooking wine, etc.), and soy sauce containers are included in this category.

• These are also collected at supermarkets.

• Place caps and labels in ♻️ marked plastics

• Rinse with water, dry

• Stomp to flatten

• Remove label

Items that cannot be collected [Please place the following items in ♻️ marked plastic]

- Seasonings (containers for oils for food, sauces, etc.)
- Non-food items (containers for detergent, shampoo, conditioner, cosmetic products, artificial products, etc.)

Hazardous waste

• Straight fluorescent bulbs, circular fluorescent bulbs

• Batteries

• Mercury body thermometers

• Place in box from time of purchase, or as is

• Place broken fluorescent and other bulbs in "non-burnable garbage".

• As much as possible, return button batteries to the button battery collection box at the store of purchase.

• As much as possible, return small rechargeable batteries (that have the ♻️ recycle mark) to the recycling box at the store of purchase.

Dangerous waste

• Gas canisters, Spray cans

• Dispose of only after using completely in order to prevent fires (It is not necessary to make a hole as something may catch fire.)

• Lighters (Disposable lighters, gas lighters, oil lighters)

• Be sure to use all product before disposing

• Place in container (storage box)
